Руководитель проекта: **Воложанина Наталья Васильевна** – учитель английского языка муниципального бюджетного общеобразовательного учреждения «Гимназия № 63 г. Челябинска».

Аннотация

Данный проект был реализован обучающимися 10 классов МБОУ «Гимназия № 63 г. Челябинска», изучающими английский язык на углублённом уровне в 2020 году. При подготовке проекта школьники учились подбирать тексты научно-популярной тематики для фонетического чтения, создавать рекламные объявления и подбирать фотографии для описания и сравнения. Обучающиеся получили большой практический опыт в отборе иллюстративного материала и составлении формулировок задания с учётом всех требований.

Цель: Создание пособия для подготовки к ЕГЭ в разделе «Устная часть»

Задачи:

- 1. Изучить структуру КИМа «ЕГЭ. Устная часть».
- 2. Подобрать материал по 4 заданиям устной части.
- 3. Создать модели заданий по установленному образцу.
- 4. Апробировать задания на уроках английского языка.
- 5. Внести необходимые коррективы.
- 6. Оформить проект.

Результативность:

Проект позволил осуществить последовательные этапы по созданию заданий по устной части ЕГЭ по английскому языку, провести апробацию и внести необходимые коррективы. В результате работы над данным проектом обучающиеся получили опыт создания КИМов устной части ЕГЭ, их оформления и презентации. Проект получил высокую оценку учителей кафедры иностранных языков МБОУ «Гимназия № 63 г. Челябинска», был апробирован в ряде гимназий и лицеев города и области.

Адресная направленность:

Практическая значимость данного материала будет полезна для учителей английского языка, т.к. этот материал можно использовать на уроках, спецкурсах и факультативных занятиях по английскому языку в рамках подготовки к устной части Единого государственного экзамена. Он также предназначен для учащихся 10 и 11 классов, осуществляющих самостоятельную подготовку к ЕГЭ по английскому языку раздела «Устная часть».

Before now, humans could only see indirect evidence that black holes even existed by looking for stars that seemed to orbit bizarre objects, by capturing radiation from the superheated matter swirling into them, or by seeing the extremely energetic jets of particles launched from their tumultuous environments. "We've been studying black holes for so long that sometimes it's easy to forget that none of us has ever seen one," National Science Foundation director said today during a press conference announcing the team's achievement, held at the National Press Club in Washington, D.C.



Photography is the art, application and practice of creating durable images by recording light or other electromagnetic radiation. Typically, a lens is used to focus the light reflected or emitted from objects into a real image on the light-sensitive surface inside a camera. With an electronic image sensor, this produces an electrical charge at each pixel, which is electronically processed and stored in a digital image file for subsequent display or processing. The result with photographic emulsion is an invisible latent image, which is later chemically "developed" into a visible image, either negative or positive depending on the purpose of the photographic material and the method of processing. A negative image on film is traditionally used to photographically create a positive image on a paper base.

The **Battle on the Ice** was fought between the Republic of Novgorod led by Prince Alexander Nevsky and the forces of the Livonian Order and Bishopric of Dorpat led by Bishop Hermann of Dorpat on April 5, 1242, at Lake Peipus. The battle is notable for having been fought largely on the frozen lake, which gave the battle its name.

A significant defeat was sustained by the crusaders during the Northern Crusades, which were directed against pagans and Eastern Orthodox Christians rather than Muslims in the Holy Land. The Crusaders' defeat in the battle marked the end of their campaigns against the Orthodox Novgorod Republic and other Slavic territories for the next century.

The event was glorified in Sergei Eisenstein's historical drama film Alexander Nevsky, released in 1938, which created a popular image of the battle often mistaken for the real events. Sergei Prokofiev turned his score for the film into a concert cantata of the same title, with "The Battle on the Ice" being its longest movement.

In 2006, Pluto was reclassified as a dwarf planet, a change widely thought of as a lower status. The question of Pluto's planet status has attracted debates in the scientific community, and among the general public. In 2017, a science group proposed a new definition of planethood based on "round objects in space smaller than stars," which would make the number of planets in our solar system expand from 8 to roughly 100.

When the core of a massive star undergoes gravitational collapse at the end of its life, protons and electrons are literally scrunched together, leaving behind one of nature's most wondrous creations: a neutron star. Neutron stars cram roughly 1.3 to 2.5 solar masses into a city-sized sphere perhaps 20 kilometers across. Matter is packed so tightly that a sugar-cube-sized amount of material would weigh more than 1 billion tons, about the same as Mount Everest!

Most known neutron stars belong to a subclass known as pulsars. These relatively young objects rotate extremely rapidly, with some spinning faster than a kitchen blender. They beam radio waves in narrow cones, which periodically sweep across Earth like lighthouse beacons. The magnetospheres of some pulsars accelerate particles to such high energies that they are relatively bright gamma-ray sources. Astronomers have found less than 2,000 pulsars, yet there should be about a billion neutron stars in our Milky Way Galaxy.

Task 1

Imagine that you are preparing a project with your friend. You have found some interesting material for the presentation and you want to read this text to your friend. You have 1.5 minutes to read the text silently, and then be ready to read it out aloud. You will not have more than 1.5 minutes to read it.

A microscope is an instrument used to see objects that are too small to be seen by the naked eye. Microscopy is the science of investigating small objects and structures using such an instrument. Microscopic means invisible to the eye unless aided by a microscope.

There are many types of microscopes, and they may be grouped in different ways. One way is to describe the way the instruments interact with a sample to create images, either by sending a beam of light or electrons to a sample in its optical path, or by scanning across, and a short distance from, the surface of a sample using a probe.

X-ray microscopes are instruments that use electromagnetic radiation usually in the soft X-ray band to image objects. Technological advances in x-ray lens optics in the early 1970s made the instrument a viable imaging choice. They are often used in tomography to produce three dimensional images of objects. Currently research is being done to improve optics for hard x-rays which have greater penetrating power.
