**Ученический проект на тему
«Write Me a Letter»**

Руководитель проекта: **Воложанина Наталья Васильевна** – учитель английского языка муниципального бюджетного общеобразовательного учреждения «Гимназия № 63 г. Челябинска».

Аннотация

Данный проект был реализован учениками 10 классов МБОУ «Гимназия № 63 г. Челябинска», изучающими английский язык на углублённом уровне. При подготовке к ЕГЭ по английскому языку обучающиеся используют задания Открытого банка ФИПИ и пособия ведущих российских и зарубежных авторов. Идея создания собственного пособия позволила каждому обучающемуся раскрыть свой творческий потенциал. При помощи практических действий, каждый ученик попробовал создать свою модель заданий, которая прошла контроль и апробацию.

Цель: Создание пособия для подготовки к ЕГЭ в разделе «Личное письмо»

Задачи:

1. Изучить структуру задания «личное письмо другу».
2. Подобрать материал по данной теме кодификатора ЕГЭ.
3. Создать модели заданий по установленному образцу.
4. Апробировать задания на уроках английского языка.
5. Внести необходимые коррективы.
6. Оформить проект.

Результативность:

Проект позволил осуществить последовательные этапы по созданию заданий по написанию личного письма, провести апробацию и внести необходимые коррективы. Процесс работы получился интересным, увлекательным, познавательным и развивающим. Обучающиеся получили опыт создания КИМов ЕГЭ, их оформления и презентации. Проект получил высокую оценку учителей кафедры иностранных языков МБОУ «Гимназия № 63 г. Челябинска», был апробирован в ряде гимназий и лицеев города и области.

Адресная направленность:

Практическая значимость данного материала будет полезна для учителей английского языка, т.к. этот материал можно использовать на уроках, спецкурсах и факультативных занятиях по английскому языку в рамках подготовки к Единому государственному экзамену. Он также предназначен для учащихся 10 и 11 классов, осуществляющих самостоятельную подготовку к ЕГЭ по английскому языку.
