"Coach"	The teacher stimulates educational group activities by creating "corporate" spirit in the student group. The main goal for a "Coach" is a positive collective result.
"Guide"	A "walking encyclopedia". "Guides" are masters of pedagogical methods and techniques, intelligent, laconic, reserved. Being technically perfect, this type of teaching is often frankly boring.
