*Музей помогает продлить память о подвиге наших соотечественниках и сохранить их до последующих поколений. В 1942 году 500 девушек-комсомолок из Чувашии призвали в войска противовоздушной обороны страны - в 101-й отдельный батальон воздушного наблюдения, оповещения и связи, сокращённо - ВНОС. Юные, нежные создания 19-23 лет от роду, достойные любви и поклонения в трудный для Родины час покинули отчий дом. Три месяца их обучали военным наукам, по звукам опознавать и отличать немецкие самолёты от русских. Девушки наблюдали за небосводом, опознавали тип самолета противника по звуку двигателя и сообщали нашему командованию о приближении авиации противника, налаживали и поддерживали связь. Соблюдался жёсткий график: дежурство – отдых – дежурство. Ежедневно, ежечасно наши девочки подвергались смертельной опасности наравне с мужчинами. Но они выдерживали*

*такой ритм работы - понимали: война. Музейный макет наблюдательного поста показывает условия службы юных защитниц Родины, военнослужащих 101-го отдельного батальона ВНОС. **До победы дошло менее половины списочного состава, а ныне их всего пять.***

*Внимательно рассматривая выставленные для всеобщего обозрения экспонаты, невольно – мысленно - переносишься в далекое военное прошлое, задумываешься о судьбе наших соотечественников, которые отстаивали независимость и свободу своего Отечества. Это история страны, история республики. Судьба целого поколения людей, молодость которых пришлась на суровые военные годы. Каждый из них, ежедневно подвергаясь смертельной опасности, несмотря*

на горе, лишения и потери, верил в неизбежность Победы, приближал её приход. Школьный музей не царство тишины и пыли, нет! Здесь регулярно проводятся встречи учеников с участниками Великой Отечественной войны, боевых действий, ветеранов тыла и труда. Эти встречи, по сути, бесценны, ведь они заставляют школьника по-новому взглянуть на историю великого прошлого нашей страны. Проводятся, начиная с 2014 года мероприятия, посвящённые Дню Неизвестного Солдата – в память о российских и советских воинах, погибших в боевых действиях на территории нашей страны. Учителя истории проводят здесь уроки истории по некоторым темам. Слушая экскурсоводов, думаешь, что с детьми можно говорить о многом, в том числе и о войне. Важно – как говорить. Надо уметь о большом и серьёзном рассказать просто, зримо, взволнованно и умно. И тогда смысл повествования, бесспорно, дойдет до ума и сердца твоего юного слушателя. Именно так закладывается основа будущего мировоззрения гражданина. Воспитать в ребенке любовь к прекрасному, а также протест против плохого – разве это не означает заложить основы его будущего мировоззрения!? Чувство гордости за отцов и дедов, которые не щадя своей жизни добывали для потомков – нас с вами – свободу и светлое будущее.



Среди экспонатов музея – предметы, свидетельствующие о национальных традициях, местных обычаях, элементы военного быта наших соотечественников, фотографии из архивов, которые представляют для всех посетителей несомненный интерес. В школьном музее Боевой славы собраны документы, правдиво повествующие о войне, позволяющие сохранить в памяти потомков историю вклада в Великую Победу нашего многонационального народа. Уверены, что музей поможет пронести через годы и десятилетия память о страшном, но героическом времени. Музей, как центр героико-патриотического, интернационального и нравственного воспитания молодежи безмолвно, но предельно красноречиво выполняет свою великую миссию – доносит эхо минувших лет, исторические факты, до нынешнего молодого поколения. А также знания и опыт, которыми старшее поколение щедро делится с учащимися школ, лицеев, а эти знания, попав в благодатную почву, дают хорошие всходы.

She was born on August 8, 1922 in the city of Yadrin. After graduating from the 8<sup>th</sup> grade, she moved to the city of Cheboksary, entered to study to be a pharmacist and at the flight school of the Cheboksary Republican Aeroclub named after Hero of the Soviet Union A.V. Lyapidevsky. After graduating from the flight school in 1939, she was sent to the flight school of the Saratov region. Due to the suspension of the recruitment of girls to the school, she returned to the city of Cheboksary and entered the cooperative technical school.

In 1942, according to a special set, she was drafted into the ranks of the Workers' and Peasants' Red Air Fleet, sent to the 3<sup>rd</sup> company

101<sup>st</sup> separate air surveillance, warning and communication battalion as part of the 79<sup>th</sup> air defense division on the 1<sup>st</sup> Belarusian Front. Ukraine, Belarus, Poland fought. She won the victory in the city of Brest, Belarusian SSR. Demobilized on June 23, 1945.

After demobilization, she worked as the head of the planning department at Stroytrust N<sup>o</sup> 2. Cheboksary. In 1977, she went on a well-deserved rest. Raised and raised her son.

She was awarded the Order of the Patriotic War of the II degree, medals "For Victory over Germany in the Great Patriotic War of 1941-1945", "Veteran of Labor", anniversary medals, etc. Active organizer of the meetings of the participants of 101 OB VNOS and the creation of the school museum of Military Glory at school N<sup>o</sup>37.

She went to the front as a volunteer on April 12, 1942, served in the rank of ensign, observer-reconnaissance of the VNOS posts, a member of the CPSU since 1944. On June 1, 1941, she graduated from the Cheboksary Biennial School. Awarded the Order of the Patriotic War of the 2<sup>nd</sup> degree, the badge "Drummer of the eleventh five-year plan", the medal "For Victory over Germany", the medal "Celebration of the 100th anniversary of the birth of V.I. Lenin", "Veteran of Labor", honorary veteran of the war and diploma of the President of the Chuvash Republic.

After demobilization, she worked as a notary of the district notary office. She was in the assets of the Republic of Kazakhstan of the CPSU and the DISTRICT EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE as a commissioner for subscription to a state debt and for agricultural work.

While retired, she conducted a lot of social work among young people. She was an active organizer of the meetings of the participants of 101 OB VNOS and the creation of the school museum of Military Glory.

Later she was a member of the museum council in the middle School N<sup>o</sup> 37 and a member of the board of the museum named after V.I. Chapaev.

Before the war, Maria Fedorovna worked as a telephone operator in Cheboksary. She went to the front on April 12, 1942. It was she, along with Masha Koroleva, who, during the fierce bombing by German planes of the Bahmach junction railway station, made her way to the city communications center and found out that the civilian telephone operators, fearing the bombing, had disappeared into an air raid shelter, leaving the communications center. The two Cars sat down at the switchboard and resumed communication with NP and BP, and with them the reflection of the Nazi air raid resumed.

After the war, she worked as a technology technician in Cheboksary printing house.

She was awarded the Order of the Patriotic War, 2nd degree, 7 medals, including the medal «For Military Merit», the badge «Excellent Air Defense». She raised seven children, for which she was awarded the Order of Motherhood of the 3<sup>rd</sup> degree, medals «Maternal Glory» of the 2nd degree.

In 1970, she graduated from the Chuvash State Pedagogical Institute, worked as a teacher of biology, chemistry and geography at the Starosnashevskaya 8-year school.

She carried out a lot of public work, was the chairman of the Committee for the Protection of Peace. The memories of her military service are kept in the museum.

Matrena Fedotovna was an observer of a observation post VNOS.

She volunteered for the army on April 12, 1942. She served in 101 OB VNOS. This is how the head of the VNOS post, Sergeant Babkina A.M., recalls the service: "One of the days our post had a broken connection 4 times, 4 times the girls restored it, and at night there was an attack on our post. All the girls did their job well.

One bandit was wounded in the shootout. The local police found him in a haystack. They were good girls, honestly served the whole war. Among these girls was Motya Udivanova."

After demobilisation, Motya returned to her village of Okas-Abashi, Morgaush district. Almost every family was in trouble: fathers, husbands, brothers did not return from the front. It was necessary to raise agriculture, it was very difficult. And so the collective farmers elected M.F. Udivanova, a little weak girl, as the head of the collective farm. Motya didn't get enough sleep at night, did everything to get the collective farm out of the breakthrough.

She was also a deputy of the Supreme Soviet of the CCP.

Life changed, everything went its own way, new people came to replace it. Matrena Fedotovna moved to the city of Cheboksary, got a job in the production association named after Chapaev, a grinder. Here she conducted public work - she was the chairman of the shop committee, a member of the bureau of the party committee of the shop.

Having gone on a well-deserved rest, she continued to work as a foreman of the Komsomol youth brigade. She became a mentor for the grinders - a team consisting of 8 girls.

And Matrena Fedotovna gave a recommendation to the party for almost everyone.
