В городе есть парк имени Л.Н. Толстого, каким же образом его имя связано с городом. Оказывается на месте современного парка были охотничьи угодья, где и любил охотиться знаменитый писатель.

Город тесно связан с именами меценатов, один из них Сергей Николаевич Горшин- коллекционер, который завещал свою коллекцию картин городу. Его имя носит галерея, которую ежегодно посещают сотни горожан. В настоящее время там проводится выставка, посвященная участникам СВО.

С Химками связано имя Михаила Юрьевича Лермонтова, в селе Середниково, где находилось имение бабушки поэта и где он проводил много времени.

В Химках родилась знаменитая детская писательница Людмила Васильевна Артемова и племянник Зинаиды Гиппиус Владимир Васильевич Гиппиус- поэт серебряного века.

В городском округе проживает известный доктор Борис Алексеевич Павлов, который не только лечит людей, но и собрал замечательный материал о Химкинских усадьбах.

Богатая природа округа всегда привлекала художников, которые запечатлели красоту края в своих полотнах, среди них Валентин Васильевич Саратов художник –пейзажист, Борис Константинович Орлов, чьи работы хранятся в знаменитых музеях, таких как Лондонская галерея и Музей современного искусства в Нью Йорке.

Химки известны как город, тесно связанный с освоением космоса. В Химках родился и по сей день является сотрудником НПО Энергомаш Виктор Николаевич Семенов. Ему уже 84 года, он автор более 600 научных статей, проводит лекции и консультации.

Известный океанолог Александр Леонидович Верещака родился в Химках, он известен своими исследованиями в области фауны мирового океана.

Химки – город спорта, здесь располагается база олимпийского резерва Новогорск, баскетбольный клуб БК Химки, игроки высшей лиги живут и тренируются в Химках.

Знаменитая лыжница и биатлонистка трижды олимпийская чемпионка по лыжам и биатлону Анфиса Анатольевна Резцова. Ежегодно на стадионе Снежинка имени А.А.Резцовой проводятся соревнования по лыжным гонкам.

В микрорайоне Сходня проживает известный комментатор, мастер спорта по гребле Дмитрий Губерниев.

Городской округ известен своим вкладом в развитие культуры в микрорайоне Подрезково родился известный основатель театра кошек Юрий Куклачев и танцор Мигель (Сергей Шестопёров).

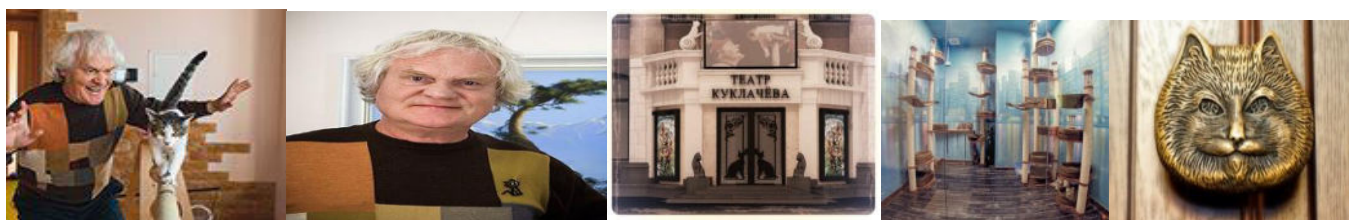

He is a well-known clown, trainer and professor. Let's find out some fascinating facts about this famous person.



YURI DMITRIEVICH KUKLACHEV

Yuri D. Kuklachyev was born on April.12-th, 1949, in Podrezkovo village, Khimki district, Moscow region. From the early childhood he has dreamt about clown's job. He has passed a difficult way to become the circus clown. His nickname was Vasilyok. Yuri Kuklachyev tried to find his own special way of performance to differ from other clowns and in the middle of 70-s, 20 century, he started to go on the stage with a cat.

The Kuklachyev Cat Theatre is the only place on the planet where animals are not just called cats, but are proudly called artists. It was opened in 1990. When entering the theatre, you are greeted by bronze cats. Rub the nose of cute animals three times, take a selfie, make a wish, and it will definitely come true. Cats are everywhere in the theatre. Even the door handles are made with images of cats. When entering the auditorium, you will definitely pet the cat. The magic curtain opens and the furry performers happily give the audience a holiday. All 200 cats live in the Crystal Castle and Cat Apartments. The Kuklachyev Theatre is recognized in the world as a "Phenomenal phenomenon in the field of art".

Yuri D. Kuklachyev has a variety of awards and titles, one of them is the People's Artist of Russia.

Anastasia Potapova

Khimki is a city located not far from the capital of Russia. A lot of famous people were born there. One of the most outstanding citizens is Anastasia Potapova. A young woman born on 30th March 2001 in the athlete family: her mother is a Master of Sports in volleyball, her grandmother is a basketball trainer. Anastasia's sports career has been predetermined long before she came into the world.

Anastasia used to watch tennis players practicing on the field. The girl could not stop staring at girls with tennis rackets. The craving for sports was founded from an early age by her grandmother.

Anastasia was working hard to achieve success and become one of the best players. In the apartment there was even a private room for intense training. She has demonstrated high results and become the strongest one even among those players who are two – three years older than she is. At that moment it was understood that the girl had a great talent and extraordinary abilities.

At the age of 9 Anastasia won her first tournament in Volgograd. Thanks to this victory she made a final decision to devote her life to professional tennis player career.

In 2013 Anastasia Potapova won a significant tournament Tennis Europe 3 O1 Properties Khimki Junior Open and was noticed by businessman and Tennis Academy founder, Alexandr Ostrovsky. He offered her to enter his sport school in Khimki and started training twice a day and meeting with a sport psychologist.

Anastasia told: "I didn't get this life as a teenager, this freedom. I didn't do much, and never really enjoyed it. At the end, we all know why I'm here and why I have such a beautiful life. It's only because of tennis."

In 2016 Anastasia took part into tournaments Pro Circuit and gained a title the first racket of the world among juniors.

Potapova has made a name for herself in professional tennis with strong performances at major tournaments, including the Australian Open, the French Open, and Wimbledon. However, her career faced a setback due to geopolitical events.

On the competitive front, Anastasia Potapova has faced various formidable opponents. These matches have not only tested her skillset but also helped in building her tenacity and public profile as a tough competitor on the international tennis circuit.

OUR COUNTRY

SPOTLIGHT ON RUSSIA goes to "Khimki Art Gallery".

A MAN WHO COULD PROTECT AND ENJOY OUR LIVES.

In 1993 Sergei Nikolaevich Gorshin founded "Art Gallery" in Khimki which still exists. Over 10 years he donated more than 200 works by Russian artists of the 19th and 20th centuries, about 500 books on fine art, and 11,000 reproductions of paintings to the town. He was one of the major collectors of Russian painting. During the war he was evacuated to Novosibirsk where he developed and modified wooden parts for the Yak aircraft. For his inventions and implementation in the production of Yak aircraft, Sergei Nikolaevich got a very significant award - the Order "Badge of Honor".

Gorshin is known to the general society as a collector and founder of "Khimki Art Gallery".

Although he did not take part in military operations his contribution to the Victory can not be overestimated. He worked at the aircraft plant together with the famous aircraft designers A.S. Yakovlev and O.K. Antonov.

That time there were no available technologies that would allow the aircraft skin to be made from lightweight and durable materials. The fuselage skin and wings were made from plywood. In order to make a structure durable, flexible and lightweight Sergey Nikolaevich Gorshin had to become a main expert. The ideas and innovations proposed by Gorshin in the design bureau allowed to increase volume of aircraft production for the front and get Victory closer. At the same time, during the war, Sergey Gorshin met an artist A.I. Bright. It was a foundation of collection of paintings and graphics. After the death of the collector, "Khimki Art Gallery" was named after Sergey Nikolaevich Gorshin. In our town citizens honor their heroes and make every effort to pass on the memory of them to the future generations.

Spotlight on Russia finds out more about aviation...

In 2005, the Air and Space Museum was opened at the Khimki Aerospace Lyceum. Its exposition has been formed over many years and continues to expand until now.

Semyon Alekseevich Lavochkin is an outstanding Soviet aircraft designer. His achievements in the field of aircraft construction have had a significant impact on aviation development worldwide. From the very beginning of World War II, the Soviet Union felt the need to develop fighters that could successfully deal with enemy aviation.



As a result, the design office of Lavochkin began work on a series of fighters, which later became known as La-serie. La-3, first launched in 1939, was one of the first fighter aircraft built in the Soviet Union after the war began. It was very popular because of its reliability, maneuverability and powerful weapons. During the Great Patriotic War, LA-3 participated in numerous combat operations and proved to be highly effective. In 1944, the designer Lavochkin released LA-7, the most advanced aircraft of the LA series. Due to its reliability and efficiency, the LA-7 has gained worldwide recognition and remains one of the most famous Soviet fighters of World War II. For the creation of LaGG-3 and La-5 Lavochkin was awarded the Stalin Prize of first degree, twice Hero of Socialist Labor (1943 and 1956). The largest missile-space enterprise located in Khimki was named in his honor.

SERGEI MIGELEVICH SHESTEPEROV (MIGUEL)

Sergey Migelevich Shestepetrov (Miguel) was born on July.21-st, 1982, in Podrezkovo village, Khimki district, Moscow region. His father, Miguel Fernando Chamblen Massa, is Cuban by origin, and his mother, Tatyana Sergeevna Shestepetrova, is Russian.

Soon his father was forced to return back to Cuba. The upbringing of the future star lay on the shoulders of his mother and grandmother.

Sergey graduated from the Moscow State University of Culture and Arts. His nickname became Miguel.

From 1999 to 2003, Miguel was a dancer in the musical about show business “Metro”.

At the end of 2004 Miguel took part in the popular television show of Channel One “Star Factory”, curated by Alla Pugacheva.

From 2008 to 2014, he acted as a choreographer and stage director at various show programs, fashion shows and theatrical events in Russia.

Miguel also acts as a director and choreographer for the tours of the show “DANCES”.

He has a variety of awards and titles.

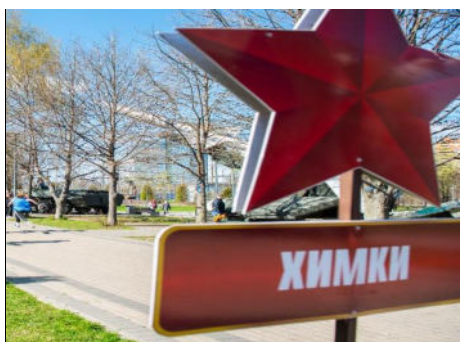

The courage and bravery of the Russian people should only be worshipped. Many years have passed since World War II, but it is impossible to remember the events of that time without shuddering. Our fathers and grandfathers made a great feat, which will forever remain in our hearts.

Evgeny Ivanovich Senatorov

Mechanic-driver of a T-34 tank-neutralizer of the 253rd Engineer Tank Regiment. He was born on December 3, 1913 in Khimki. He was brought up in a simple working-class family. In 1926 he graduated from Moscow secondary school.

**Cavalier of the Order of
Glory**

**‘Heroes do not burn in
tanks!’**



The tanker passed the combat way from Finland to Manchuria. For these battles he received the first award - the medal “For bravery”.

In August, 1943 in fights of Smolensk offensive operation he destroyed 30 soldiers and officers of the enemy, 1 anti-tank gun, broke 2 bazookas with the gun of his tank. On the morning of June 23, 1944, Senatorov, a senior mechanic-driver of a T-34 tank, led the fighting vehicle through the swampy terrain despite the danger. His tank crew was the first to reach the crossing and prevented the German sappers from blowing it up. Having captured the crossing, the tankers attacked the Zamostochie railroad station. During the battle Senatorov's crew destroyed 3 dugouts, 3 motorcycles with drivers and over 10 soldiers and officers. The tankers freed a large group of Soviet citizens whom the Germans had taken into captivity.

He participated in the battles in East Prussia. On October 16, 1944 he drove a tank through minefields, detonated up to 20 mines, was wounded, but did not leave the battlefield. He was awarded the Order of the Red Star and became a full cavalier of the Order of Glory. In 1946 he was demobilized. He returned to his native town Khimki and worked as a foreman at the factory. He died on June 10, 2005.

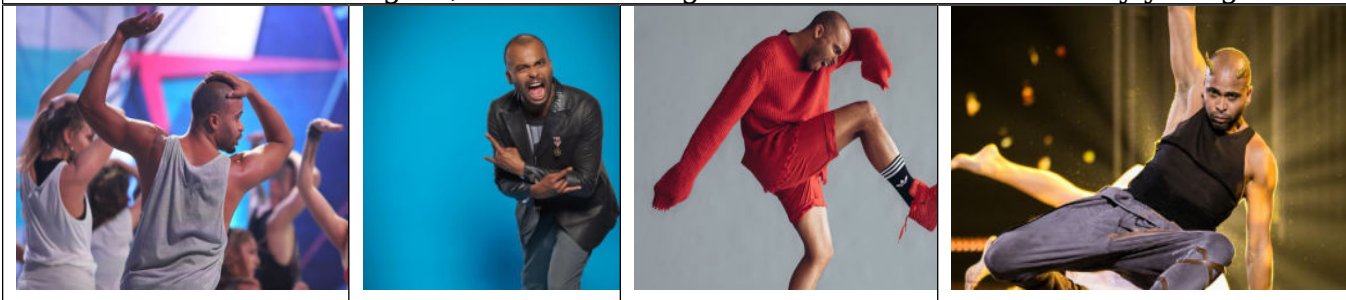

MIGUEL

Russia has an exceptional culture and history. Russian writers, scientists, artists, actors, film-makers are highly regarded all over the world. It is important to know that some of these remarkable people are from Khimki, Moscow oblast. This article is about one of them — Miguel, an outstanding dancer and the idol of many youngsters.



Sergey Shesteporov, widely known as Miguel, born on July 21, 1982, in Khimki, is a Russian director, choreographer, producer, and actor. From his childhood, Miguel was fond of art and at the age of four came up with his first dance performance. He staged the ballet "Swan Lake" and demonstrated wonderful dancing and organizational skills.

He has always stood out not only for his talent but also for his striking appearance inherited from his father (a Cuban by nationality). At school he became an object of bullying among his peers, so he had to finish school as an external. But it didn't stop him from his creative ambitions, he continued choreographing and staging successful dance projects. Miguel's career began with participation in the musical "Metro". Later he appeared in the productions of "Notre Dame de Paris" and "Romeo and Juliet". Then Miguel became a participant in the TV project "Star Factory-5" under the direction of Alla Pugacheva.

Miguel has organized numerous concerts, fashion shows, and has staged clips for many Russian celebrities. But the greatest success and recognition came to him after his active participation in the TV show called "Dancing" on TNT where he was one of the choreographers and juries. At the same time, the artist worked at "ProTantsi" one of the most outstanding choreographic schools in Russia.

VLADIMIR VASILIEVICH GIPPIUS**

Each Russian city has an exciting history and a lot of outstanding people who were born on its territory. So, Khimki is not exception – we are very proud of Vladimir Vasilievich Gippius, a Russian poet of the Silver Age, a literary critic.

**VLADIMIR VASILIEVICH GIPPIUS**

Vladimir Vasilyevich Gippius was born on July, 15th, in 1876 in Khimki, Moscow region. Brother of the poet V. V. Gippius, cousin of the poetess Z. N. Gippius, father of the musicologist E. V. Gippius. Speaking of Vladimir Vasilyevich Gippius, we should start with the fact that he was a gymnasium teacher of Mandelstam and Nabokov. A teacher, and then the director of the Tenishevsky School in St. Petersburg, Vladimir Gippius started his studies at the gymnasium with A. Dobrolyubov, and began his literary career with him, becoming known as one of the first decadents in Russia. As a student of the Faculty of History and Philology at St. Petersburg University, he published a collection of poems "Songs". Later he published the book "The Return" and the collection "Night in the Stars". A few years later, working like a director of the Tenishevsky School, Gippius wrote poetry in fits and starts: after publishing another collection, he often departed from creativity. Speaking with A. Dobrolyubov, he preached even more shocking decadence than Bryusov in Moscow in the same years. The teacher and educator struggled in him with an aesthete, an individualist, which is why Gippius called himself, not without irony, a "penitent decadent"; later he paid tribute to religious sentiments. In the 1910s, he became known for literary and public performances; in articles about classical and contemporary writers, he asserted the spiritually transformative mission of literature. In 1916, his poem "Falling in Love" was published in the "Almanac of the Muses". Vladimir Gippius died of starvation in 1941 during the siege of Leningrad.

Khimki is not just a satellite city of Moscow. It is a place where history intertwines with modernity, where you can meet great personalities and ordinary people. The city that can boast of its rich past full of bright events and famous names. Sergey Shesteyorov, better known as Miguel, was born on July 21, 1982, in the city of Khimki, Moscow region.

Miguel only met his father, who returned to Cuba in the 1980s, in 2014. He is a Russian film director, choreographer, and producer. He was a ballet artist in popular musicals such as "Metro," "Notre-Dame de Paris," and "Romeo and Juliet," and he was a finalist on "Fabrika Zvyozd" .

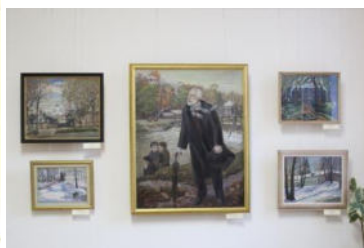
Miguel attended a school in Zelenograd for the first two grades. He completed his tenth and eleventh grades externally. At 19, he entered the Moscow State University of Culture and Arts.

Thanks to his grandmother, he got acquainted with the choreography of Michael Jackson. The King of Pop became an idol for him, setting the direction for his future creative activity. In the spring of 2011, the grand dance show "Maidan's" premiered on the Ukrainian television channel "Inter." Miguel was one of the inspirers of this television show. He worked on the project as the chief choreographer, the music producer, and a member of the jury. The project "Maidan's" was officially enrolled into the Guinness World Records as the largest and the most massive dance project in the world. In the summer of 2014, Miguel became a co-producer, a choreographer, "a mentor," and a jury member of a new grand show called "Dances" on the Russian television channel TNT.

**OUTSTANDING PEOPLE OF KHMINKI – Sergey Nikolaevich Gorshin**

There are a lot of people in Khimki, who glorify the city by their achievements in different spheres. Some of them were born in Khimki, others lived and worked here. We are very proud of their contribution for work in the factories and plants, science achievements and cultural impact. Let's read about a famous person Sergey Nikolaevich Gorshin, Doctor of Technical Science and art collector. He is an Honorary Freeman of Khimki.

SERGEY NIKOLAEVICH GORSHIN

If you walk around the city you can see a small street named Gorshina street. Let's find out why it is named after this person.

Though Sergey Gorshin wasn't born in Khimki, he lived most of his life in our town.

He was born in 1908 in the village in Penza region. In 1920 his family moved to Saransk. During this time he became interested in natural science and started his first collection of prints and cards. After graduating from Kazan University he devoted his life to protecting plants and forest and studied wood issues. He succeeded in it and in 1937 he was granted a degree for his scientific work.

During the war Sergey Gorshin was evacuated to Novosibirsk where he worked at the aircraft factory, producing wood parts. There he got acquainted with the artist Bright. This was the turning point in forming Gorshin's collection of paintings and graphics. He bought first pictures by A.Sokolova, I.Bilibin and K.Makovsky.

In 1947 he returned to Khimki and resumed his scientific work. Also he continued collecting pictures of realistic paintings and graphics by Russian artists of 19th-20th centuries. In 1991 he opened Khimki Picture Gallery. He presented 203 pictures by Russian artist, 500 books about art and 11000 prints. Now the gallery is named after Sergey Gorshin. It is a favourite place among the locals and guests.

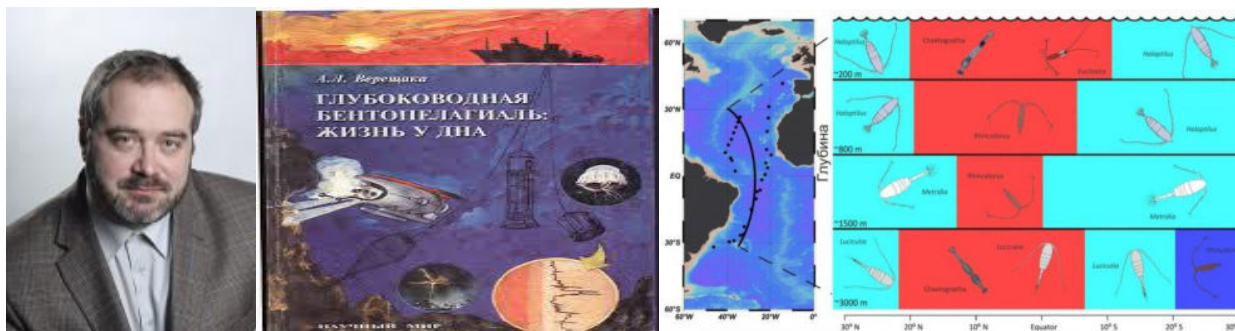

Almost every city has an outstanding person who was born on its territory. Proudly we can say that Khimki is one of the many cities which has outstanding people. Here we will study some interesting facts about Russian oceanologist Doctor of Biological Sciences, professor, corresponding member of the Russian Academy of Sciences.

Vereshchaka Alexander Leonidovich was born in July 16, 1965, Khimki. In 1987 he graduated from the Faculty of Biology of Moscow State University. In 1990 he got a PHD degree of Biological Sciences in P. P. Shirshov Institute of Oceanology. He has been a corresponding Member of the Russian Academy of Sciences in the Department of Earth Sciences since December 22, 2011.

Vereshchaka Alexander Leonidovich conducts teaching work, he is the author of a number of textbooks. He is a specialist in the field of geoecology and oceanology, the author of about 100 scientific papers, including 5 monographs (2 in English), and 6 collective monographs (in 3 — the responsible editor). The main scientific results were obtained using modern methods: “Mir” manned deep-sea vehicles (11 expeditions, more than 20 dives), molecular genetic methods.

It's important to mention that he was invited to give lectures on marine biology and to carry out joint work in France, the USA, Denmark, Norway, New Zealand. 3 PhD theses were prepared under his supervision.

He described 2 new families of shrimp, about 50 new genera and species of crustaceans. He has written two textbooks: "Marine Biology" for general students and "Fundamentals of Marine Ecology" for students related to applied cosmonautics.

Boris Orlov: “My creative work is the marking of time”. Boris Konstantinovich Orlov was born in Khimki on the 1st of April in 1941. He is a modern painter, sculptor and installation artist. He received his professional education in ‘Stroganov university’. Together with his friends he created a new art movement – Soviet Underground Art. Orlov’s works are made in an Imperial style.

Boris Konstantinovich Orlov - he is called a modern domestic art classic.

His works are represented in the biggest museums around the world and in private collections:

- Solomon R. Guggenheim Museum, New York
- Museum of Modern Art, New York
- Tate Gallery, London
- Collection of C.S. Olympic park, Seoul

His most famous works are: “Military man”, “Sailor”, “Rooster”, “Little fish”, “Female bust”.

Orlov is almost the only real sculptor among the unofficial Soviet artists. His works, even those combining the most variegated materials, images, and meanings, are not objects but sculptures, and they do not look assembled but erected. Erected for the centuries, as is appropriate for sculpture, perhaps the most imperial form of art.

The Patrons of the Land of Khimki



"The prosperity of the arts requires both painters and patrons," wrote K.S. Stanislavsky. The names of Russian **patrons** are known worldwide. They invested not only money but also their energy and souls into developing Russian culture. Today, monuments across Russia remind us of their **contributions**.

One of Khimki's first patrons was the merchant **Christophor Semenovich Ledentsov** (1824–1907). He owned land in Skhodnya and worked with famous scientists like S.A. Fedorov, K.A. Timiryazev, and I.M. Sechenov. Ledentsov funded science and education, supporting institutions such as:

- The Institute of Biophysics and Physics in St. Petersburg,
- Pavlov's and Zhukovsky's **laboratories**,
- Moscow Technical College's propeller-testing labs.
- Two lanes in Skhodnya have his name in his honor.



Another notable patron was **Grigory Antonovich Zakharin** (1829–1897), who owned Kurkino village. A Doctor of Medicine, Professor, he gave part of his salary to poor students and **donated** 500,000 roubles to schools in Saratov and Penza. He also helped build Moscow's Museum of Fine Arts. During the Serbo-Turkish War, he funded a medical team for Serbia and gave 45,000 francs for a water supply in Danilovgrad.



Khimki also hosted famous cultural figures. **Pavel Mikhailovich Tretyakov** (1832–1898), founder of the Tretyakov Gallery, often visited his friend S.I. Mamontov in Kireevo. There, he met his future wife, Vera Mamontova. Tretyakov supported Khimki by funding a school for the **deaf** near the train station, where Vera later taught.



Patronage continued in the 20th century. For example, **Petr Dmitrievich Grushin** (1906–1993), an academician and the chief designer of MKB "Fakel", donated 150,000 roubles in the 1980s to build the **House for Young Technicians** in Khimki. Petr Grushin, who designed aircraft and anti-aircraft missiles, cared deeply for youth education. Thanks to him, young Khimki residents still enjoy learning technical skills of modelling there today.

In Khimki, a memorial to S.P.Bogdanovsky, who headed Scientific and Production Association “Energomash” from 1968 to 1992, appeared on Mira Avenue. S.P.Bogdanovsky is an Honorary citizen of the city district, a participant in the Great Patriotic War, a laureate of the USSR State Prize, Doctor of Technical Sciences.

In 1949, he began his career as an engineer at the enterprise and passed all the stages of engineering growth. For 23 years he was the permanent director of the SPA “Energomash” plant. Under his leadership, the plant’s team produced a rocket engine for the Energia-Buran missile system, which has no equal in the world. Our compatriot has received recognition for his contribution to the creation of new engine production technologies. Under him, “Energomash” became a city-forming enterprise. Many socio-cultural and sports facilities were built during the years of his plant management. Entire residential districts appeared. Kindergartens, schools, polyclinics, clinical hospital 119, “Pobeda” swimming pool, pioneer camps were built.

“With enormous employment, Stanislav Petrovich found time to meet with young specialists, many of whom he helped to find themselves and build a career”, - Dmitry Voloshin, the head of the city district commented on the opening of the monument.

S.P.Bogdanovsky’s life and career is an example of faithful service to the Fatherland. The newly opened memorial to the outstanding man of our Small Homeland is another reminder of the great past, of one of the outstanding people whose work paved the way for our country into Space.

RUDNEV PAVEL ANDREEVICH

Pavel A. Rudnev was born on April.22-nd, 1976, in Khimki, Moscow region. From an early age, he was interested in theatrical art, which eventually led him to study at the Theater Faculty of GITIS. He is the author of more than 1,000 articles in various publications. From 2003 to 2018, he taught at GITIS and graduated three theater studies courses.

Pavel A. Rudnev is a person, who sees theater not only as entertainment, but also as a deep socio-cultural process. In one of his interviews, he emphasizes that the main task of a critic is to name new phenomena, mark trends and analyze creative processes taking place on the theater stage. Thanks to this, the theater gets the opportunity to develop and change, and the audience can discover new things for themselves.

Recalling his path in theatrical art, Pavel admits that in his youth he had no idols, but later the world of theater became enriched for him with the names of great directors such as Yuri Butusov and Dmitry Krymov. In his opinion, they open the doors to the future of the theater of the 21st century, forcing the audience to rethink the usual ideas about the performing arts.

Pavel A. Rudnev is also a talented translator. He translated a number of plays by modern foreign playwrights into Russian. Besides, he hosts a video blog about theater premiers.

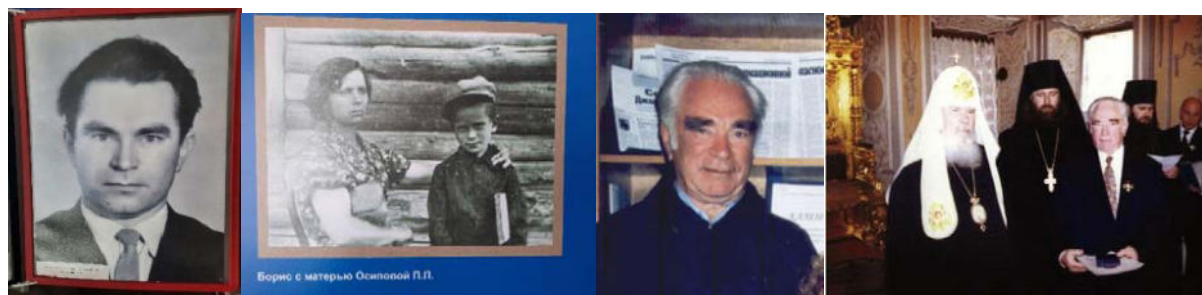

Our wonderful Khimki is very rich with outstanding people and always was. Scientists, artists, politicians, playwrights, sportsmen – all these people are the pride of our town. Today we will speak about a unique person - Boris Alekseevich Pavlov, a wonderful doctor, scientist and a talented local historian at the same time.



BORIS ALEKSEEVICH PAVLOV

Boris A. Pavlov was born on August.27-th, 1931, in Pugovitsino village, Leningrad region. He was a child of war (the Great Patriotic War) and knew well enough the pain and hardships of this terrible period. That is why he tried to do good as much as possible - he decided to become a doctor. Boris Alekseevich graduated from medical school and began working in a hospital, first in the Tomsk region, then in Khimki.

The young doctor was dedicated to his profession. His patients loved and respected him. In this period, he was involved in medical research work and wrote many scientific papers.

In 1975 Boris Alekseevich became interested in local history. He collected photographs and oral stories of the citizens and published them in small books. He wrote more than 150 articles on local history which were published in the regional press. Two of his most significant works on local history are “On Khimki land” (2003) and “Khimki: mansions, villages and tiny hamlets, outstanding people” (2006).

In Khimki, by the way, in the museum of Lyceum No. 10 there is a memorable section dedicated to this wonderful man and a small exhibition about him: “The life and creative path of B.A. Pavlov”. There’s also a memorial plaque with his portrait hanging there.

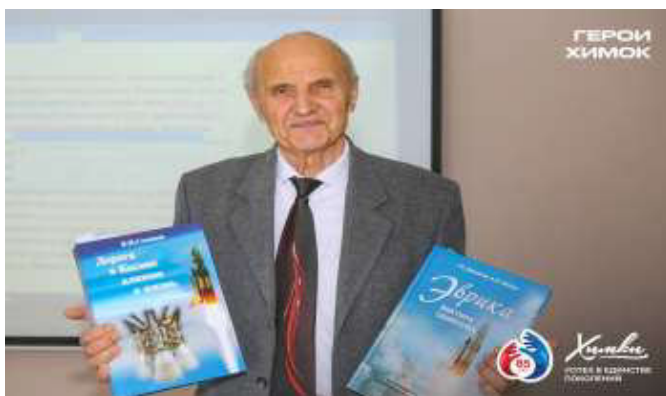

Every place on Earth – big or small - can be proud of some of its citizens whose achievements are really impressive. Spotlight on Khimki looks at the outstanding people of our city

Victor Semenov – inventor and scientific writer



Viktor Semenov was an ordinary young man when he graduated from the Khimki Mechanical College and got a job as an inspector in the turbopump unit shop of NPO "Energomash". Here he climbed the career ladder to the chief engineer of the enterprise, and later - the chief researcher

of the research center, which is nowadays part of Roscosmos. More than 200 inventions have been patented under the authorship of Viktor Nikonorovich during his long career, and they are actively used in the space industry. The scientist's discoveries became a springboard for assigning Khimki the status of a science city. Under his leadership, the first ecological map of Khimki was developed, and projects for the processing of industrial and household waste have improved the situation in the field of environmental protection of the district.

Viktor Semenov has written over 300 scientific papers in the fields of soldering, welding, materials science and physics. He has also made two world-class scientific discoveries. Back in the 1970s, as an engineer at Energomash, he created a liquid rocket engine. Such engines are still used today to send people and cargo into orbit. Over his many years of work, Viktor Nikonorovich has become a laureate of two State Prizes, a presidential scholarship holder in the field of science, a laureate of the Academician V.P. Glushko Prize.

Viktor Nikonorovich is already 84 years old. He continues his work, lectures at universities and writes his books.

Heroes of Khimki: Nikolay Domoratsky - china jubilee of management of Novogorsk Training Centre



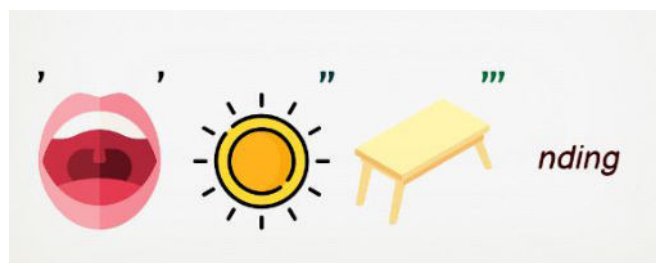
There are many outstanding people in Khimki who glorify the city with their achievements. These are employees from various spheres of activity. Among those who have made a huge contribution to the development of the district

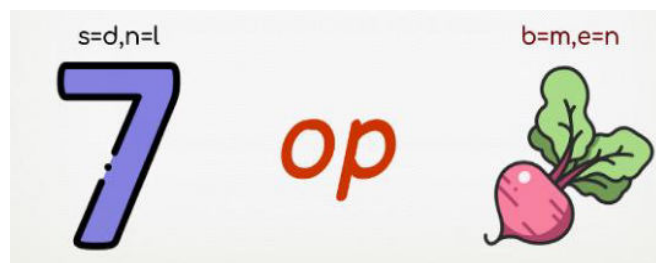

Vladimir Ivanovich Morozov - a Soviet sprint canoeist

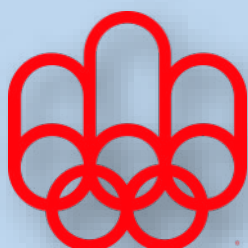


Canoe sprint is a water sport in which athletes race in specially designed sprint canoes on calm water over a short distance. Prior to November 2008, canoe sprint was known as flatwater racing. The term is still in use today but is often used as a hypernym for both canoe marathon and canoe sprint.



Vladimir Ivanovich Morozov (Sometimes shown as Vladimir Morosov, born 19 June 1952 in Moscow Oblast, Khimki district) was a Soviet sprint canoeist who competed in the late 1970s. He won a gold medal in the K-4 1000 m event at the 1976 Summer Olympics in Montreal, Quebec, Canada.

Morozov also won four medals at the ICF Canoe Sprint World Championships with three golds (K-4 10000 m 1977, 1978, 1979) and a silver (K-4 1000 m 1977).

His name is Sergey Shesteporov, he has no African roots and started his career as a singer. What else don't we know about your favorite choreographer?

Now Miguel is a well-known choreographer, who holds an honorary place in the jury of one of the highest-rated shows in the country. But thirty-nine years ago, he was born in Khimki near Moscow...

In fact, Miguel is the name of the choreographer's father. Miguel Fernando Chamblain Messo, a Cuban officer and Tatyana Shesteporova are Sergey's parents.

The boy turned out to be talented: Sergey was in Year Five at school when his mother saw his unusual plasticity, sent him to the "Fuete" ballet school. Three years later he quit ballet, deciding that he would choose a different dance direction in the future. But he realized that he would be engaged in dancing.

Miguel entered the choreographic department of the Moscow Institute of Culture. The student had to study the direct manner of Michael Jackson. The famous plastic of the king of pop music formed the basis of the new style.

The first season of the largest Russian dance project "Dances" started on the TNT channel on August 23, 2014. Miguel, together with choreographer Yegor Druzhinin, became a mentor of the project, as well as a member of the jury.

Miguel is also the director and choreographer of the DANCE project's tours, which gathered together more than 120 cities across Russia.

ALEXEY ANATOLYEVICH KHARKOV

Alexey Anatolyevich Kharkov was born on September 5th, 1977, in Khimki, Moscow region. He started playing in a school band "Left Bank". Later, for some time he participated in the Khimki gothic band "Voiceless Void", from which he moved to the hard rock band "Russian America". The band released the album "Alaska", gave several concerts in support of the album and shot a video clip, but soon stopped its activities due to musical differences between the participants and the lack of sponsorship.

In 1999, Alexey Kharkov entered the Regional College of Arts at the faculty of variety arts. When Alexey found out that Sergey Mavrin, a talented musician, was looking for a new bass player in his band, he passed the auditions and became a member of a new band "Mavrik".

After the split of Russian heavy metal band "Aria" in 2002 its former members formed a musical group "Kipelov" and Kharkov became their bass guitarist. In 2005, he debuted as a composer, writing music for the songs "Obsession" and "Rivers of Time". He was a co-author of Valery Kipelov, a famous rock musician and honored artist of the Russian Federation.

Nowadays, "Kipelov" continues to give live music concerts performing both the golden collection of Russian Rock and new singles. On July 13th, 2024, the band held a big summer concert at the VTB Arena for 11, 000 fans. As Alexey Kharkov says, "The main thing is not to lose your courage!"

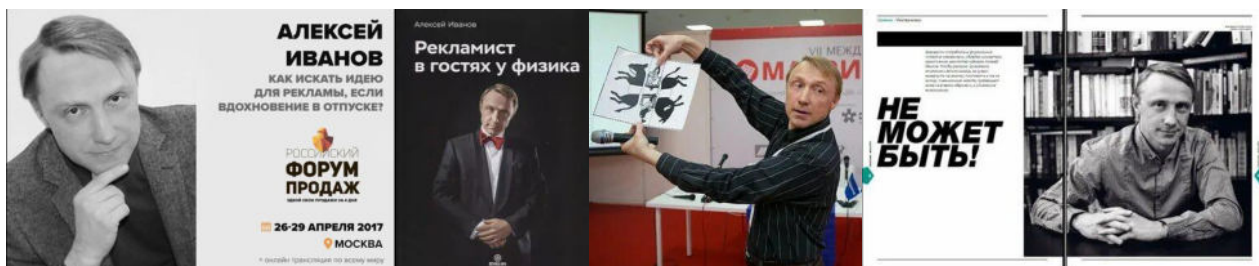

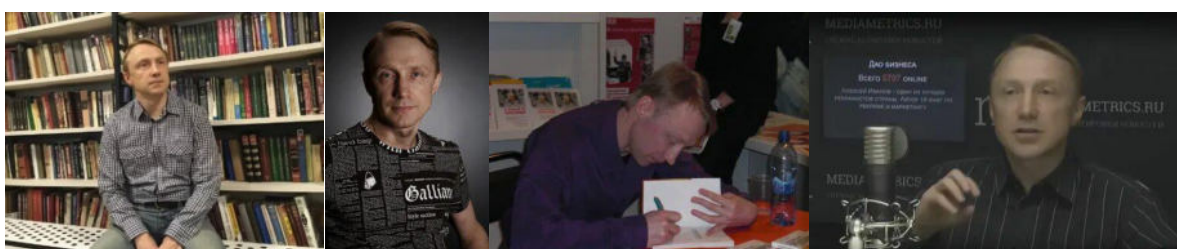

Alexey Ivanov

Every Russian city has a wonderful history and many outstanding people who were born on its territory. So, our native Khimki is not exception – we are very proud of Alexey Ivanov! He is a Russian advertiser, speaker, and author of best-selling books on advertising and marketing. Let's find out some fascinating facts about this multifaceted person.



IVANOV ALEXEY NIKOLAEVICH

Alexey Nikolaevich Ivanov was born on February 4th, 1969 in Khimki in a family of mechanical engineers for aircraft and spacecraft. He studied in Moscow at the Physics and Mathematics boarding school № 18. In 1991, he graduated with honors from the Moscow Institute of Physics and Technology and continued his studies at the graduate school of MIPT. In 1993, he interned at Space Exploration Associates in the USA. In 1994, on the basis of NIITP, he prematurely defended his dissertation on the topic "Kinetics of degradation processes in beam plasma" and received the degree of Candidate of Physical and mathematical Sciences.

Many years later Alexey Ivanov said in his interview that when he wrote the introductory essay and was accepted to Phys Tech, he was relieved to think "This is the last essay in my life! Now I will only write formulas." But fate turned out differently ... He had to go back to pen and paper. His book about free advertising was published, which became a business bestseller.

He started working in the advertising industry in 1993 as a copywriter for BBDO Marketing. After that, he worked for the agencies Young&Rubicam, Publicis United Campaigns and Advent. He created advertisements for the brands Nestlé, Unilever, Nissan, Lufthansa, Wimm-Bill-Dann, the chocolate factory "Russia" and Coca-Cola. He is the author of the slogans "It's good to have a house in the village", "Maggi. Small victories every day", "Nuts is a tough nut to crack" and others. Alexey Nikolaevich belongs to the first generation of domestic advertisers.

In 2002, he founded his own advertising agency "MasterUm" (<https://mastermind.ru/>). This company offers non-standard marketing ideas for advertising in various media (from television to the Internet) and original sales techniques. The Agency's mission is working to reduce the number of stupid ads that offend human intelligence!

Since 2008, as an invited speaker, he has conducted master classes on the theory and practice of advertising at Moscow State University, MIPT, Higher School of Economics, Peoples' Friendship University of Russia (RUDN), Russian University of Transport (MIIT), the Russian New University (RosNOU), as well as in other universities and schools.



The first book he wrote was "Free advertising: a result without a budget". In February 2010, in the first month of sales, "Free Advertising" became a bestseller, overtaking books by Philip Kotler, Stephen Covey, Jack Trout and other celebrities. It was a significant informational occasion. He couldn't pass by the journalists unnoticed. Since then, they have been keeping a close eye on Ivanov. Their visits were more often than friends' one. They called more often than relatives. People with dictaphones and cameras regularly found out the secrets of the advertising business.

Articles and reviews of Ivanov's books were published in such magazines as "Forbes", "Kommersant", "Expert", "Profile", "Company", "CEO", "Commercial Director", "Psychologies", "MAXIM" (with an announcement on the cover), "Snob", "Science and Life", "Chemistry and Life", "For Science", newspapers "Moskovskaya Pravda", "Evening Moscow", "Business Moscow", "Literary newspaper", "Our Version", on Business FM radio, City FM, MediaMetrics and television.

Book presentations, creative meetings of the author with readers and journalists took place at the XIII national exhibition "Books of Russia" at the All-Russian Exhibition Center, the XXIII Moscow International Book Fair, at the "Moscow House of Books" on Novy Arbat, "Biblio-Globus", "Molodaya Gvardiya" and in the bookstores "Republic".

In 2014, the book "How to come up with an idea if you are not Ogilvy" was published where eight creative techniques are described and put into a system. At the end of the year, the online educational platform Netologia included the work in the list of the 11 best books on marketing.

In 2024, for the 50th anniversary of the game "What? Where? When?" the book "Secrets of the black box. How to find the answer in a minute" was published, where the author uses advertising methods to solve questions from the legendary TV show.

The advertiser's works are stored in the British Library, the national libraries of Russia, Germany, Sweden, Israel, Singapore, the Royal Library of Denmark, the libraries of Harvard, Columbia, Illinois, Stanford universities and other book depositories.

Alexey Nikolaevich Ivanov is undoubtedly an outstanding figure in Russia - a creative advertising writer, an innovator of his ideas. He was able to change the attitude towards advertising not only in our country, but all over the world!

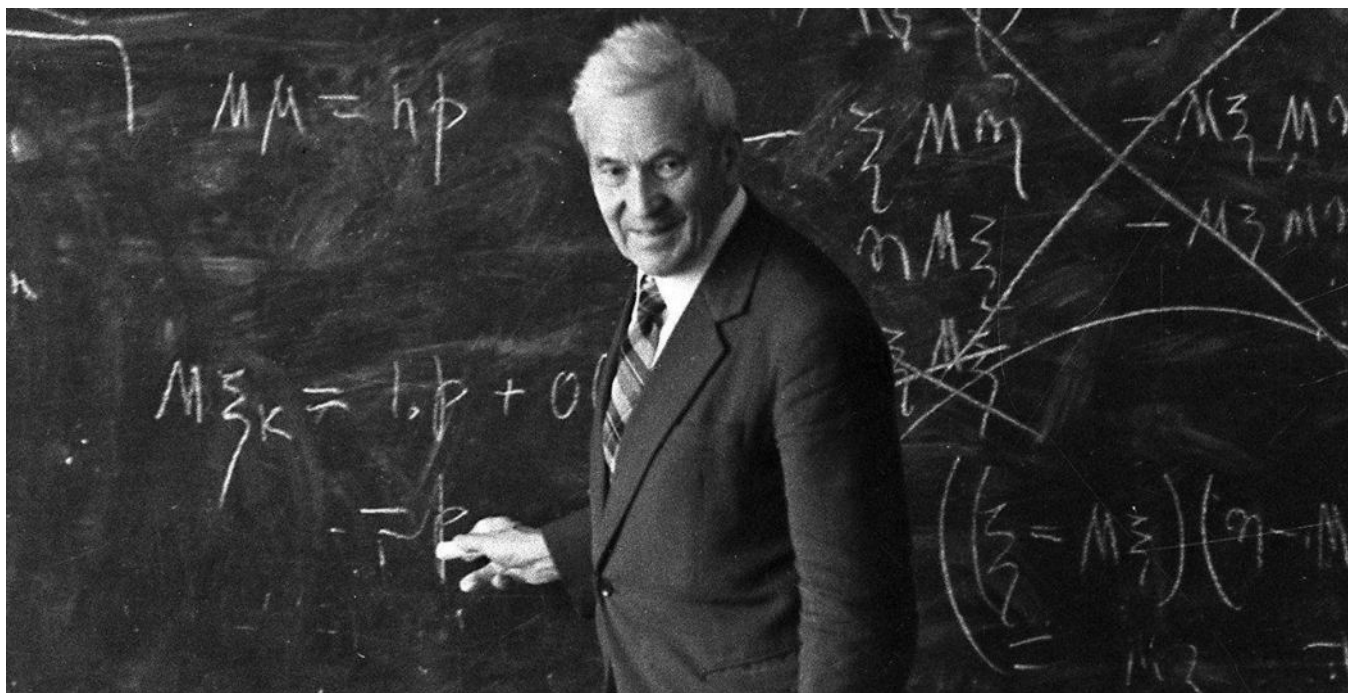

He has been working as a mathematics teacher at Lyceum No. 6 for 32 years.



Marlene Nikolaevich – is a true professional in his field!

Despite his extensive work experience in the field, Mr. Ivanov continues to be interested in reading new methodological materials and learning about current trends in mathematics teaching. Over the past few years, he has worked on the topic of "Activating Students' Mental Activity in Mathematics Lessons" and is currently investigating the topic of "Developing Students' System Thinking". At meetings of the Lyceum's Mathematics Teachers' Methodological Association, he has on several occasions shared his pedagogical insights on these subjects with his colleagues.

As a teacher by profession, Mr. M. N. Ivanov is a highly skilled mentor who has assisted several junior mathematics teachers in their professional development. Thanks to his extensive knowledge, patience, and expertise, junior teachers are provided with competent guidance and support during the early stages of their teaching careers.

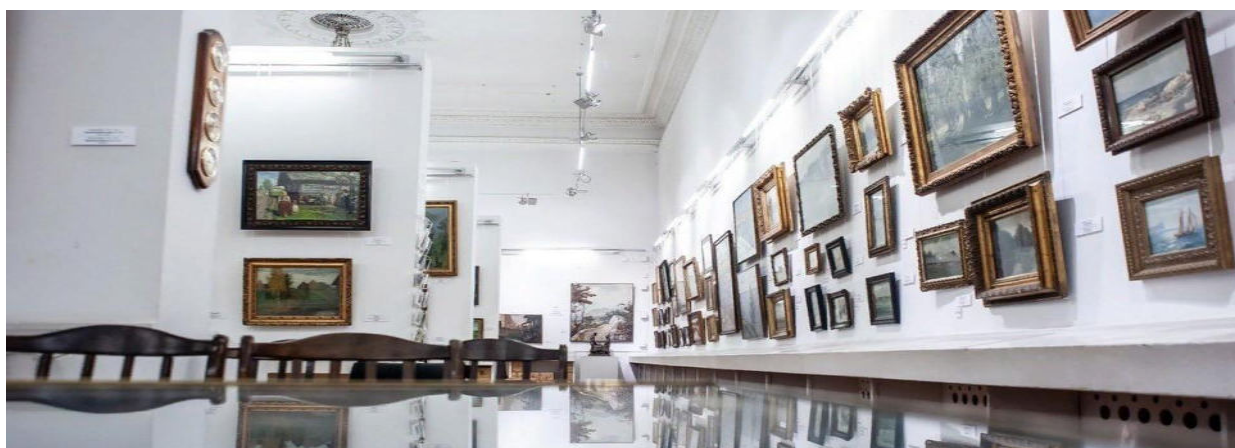

Gorshin Sergey

Sergei Nikolaevich was not a professional artist or art critic, but he enjoyed the highest level of respect from both. In his field of expertise, which was forest protection and forestry management, he was widely recognized as a Doctor of Technical Sciences and an Honored Scientist and Technologist of the Russian Soviet Federated Socialist Republic. He held the position of Professor.



Sometimes young people do not know what a scientist who has a PhD in forestry does in a place where they make planes for the army. The answer is easy. There were no good ways to make the skin of a plane from light and strong materials. They needed someone who knows about different types of wood and can make new materials from it. Sergey Nikolaevich Gorshin was that person.

The ideas and new things that Gorshin suggested in the design office helped to make a lot more planes for the war. It helped to bring victory closer.

On the occasion of the 100th anniversary of the birth of a local scientist, collector and philanthropist, which was solemnly celebrated at the end of September, it was decided to name the street after him, previously designated as passage No. 6010.



In 1993, Sergey Nikolaevich Gorshin established an art gallery in the city of Khimki, which continues to operate today. Over a period of 10 years, the gallery presented the city with over 200 original works by Russian painters from the 19th and 20th centuries, approximately 500 publications on fine art, and 11,000 copies of paintings.

Sergey Migelyevich Shestepetrov was born on July 21st, 1982, in Khimki, Moscow region. His stage name, Miguel, was taken after his father, Miguel Fernando Champlain. He chose this name in honor of his father, who was Cuban and gave him such a colorful appearance. The current successful dancer was raised and educated by his mother, an electrical engineer, and grandmother, a teacher of Russian and literature.

Miguel's Passion for the art of dance arose in early childhood – since he saw scenes from the ballet "Giselle" on TV at the age of four. From fifth to eighth grade, he attended Children's Choreography school and then continued to master his artistic abilities at the Choreographic School at the Bolshoi Theater.

Miguel also participated in such major projects as the Star Factory, was a ballet dancer in the musicals - Metro and Notre Dame de Paris.

For a long time, he has been a mentor on the TV show "Dances" and now has his own dance studio.

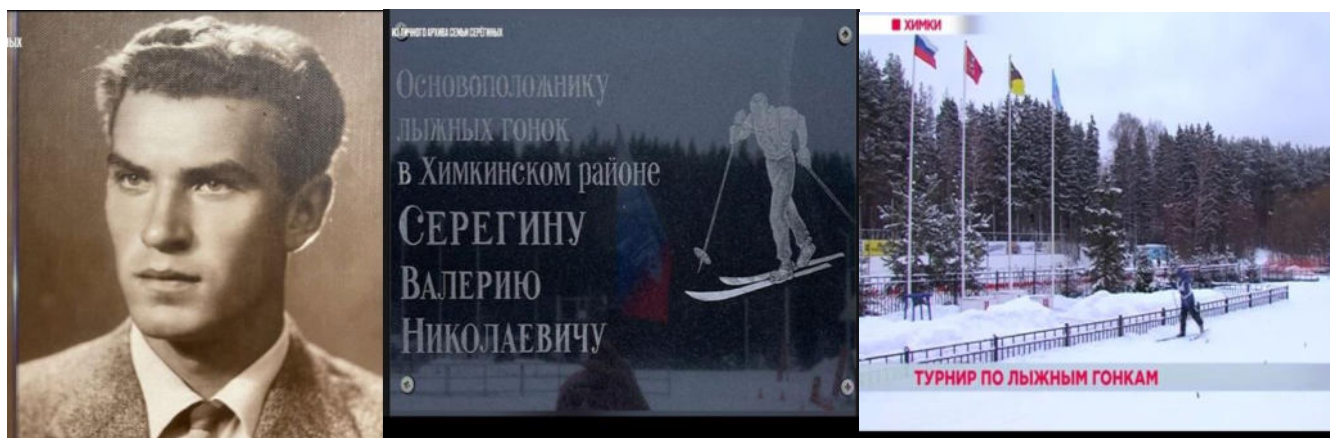

Khimki City District is rightfully considered to be the sports capital of the Moscow region. There are winners and prize-winners of All-Russian and International competitions, as well as Olympic and Paralympic Games among the residents of Khimki.

Valery Nikolaevich Seregin is a well-known coach and teacher. He was a founder of skiing in Khimki. Valery Seregin was born in Paveltsevo, Moscow region. In 1959 he graduated from the Institute of Physical Education and was assigned to the School of the Olympic Reserve of Khimki.

Valery Nikolaevich devoted all his life to sports, his students. He taught his students to be friends, support each other, respect the opponents, not to lose heart in difficult situations. During his career Valery Seregin raised about 5 thousand athletes. More than 50 of his students graduated from the Institute of Physical Education. Valery Nikolaevich Seregin died in 1995. Every year on December 30 a race in memory of the coach-teacher is held in Khimki. There is a memorial plaque in his honor at the Khimki stadium «Snowflake».

Observing her sister's training, Natalya got inspired to give it a go and started with a rapier, but later she was invited to try herself in saber fencing, which turned out to be something that Natalya had a way with. It wasn't long before Makeyeva represented Russia on the global stage, bringing pride to her hometown of Khimki. Natalya mentions European Championship in France in 2003, where she won team gold and silver in individual competition, as one of the most memorable. The World Championship 2002 doesn't pale into insignificance as well, because Natalya's team was on the brink of failure, but in the final round they managed to snatch the victory.



Having completed the sports career, Natalya Makeyeva has found her place in the Fencing Federation of Moscow region, where she has got a hand in discovering and developing new talents. She also firmly believes that continuity of generations is a key to winning traditions and it has already born fruit, since their athletes are one of the leaders among Russian fencers.

To crown it all, Natalya Makeyeva's success and determination not only cemented her status as a top-tier fencer but also positioned her as a role model for young, aspiring fencers in Russia and beyond.

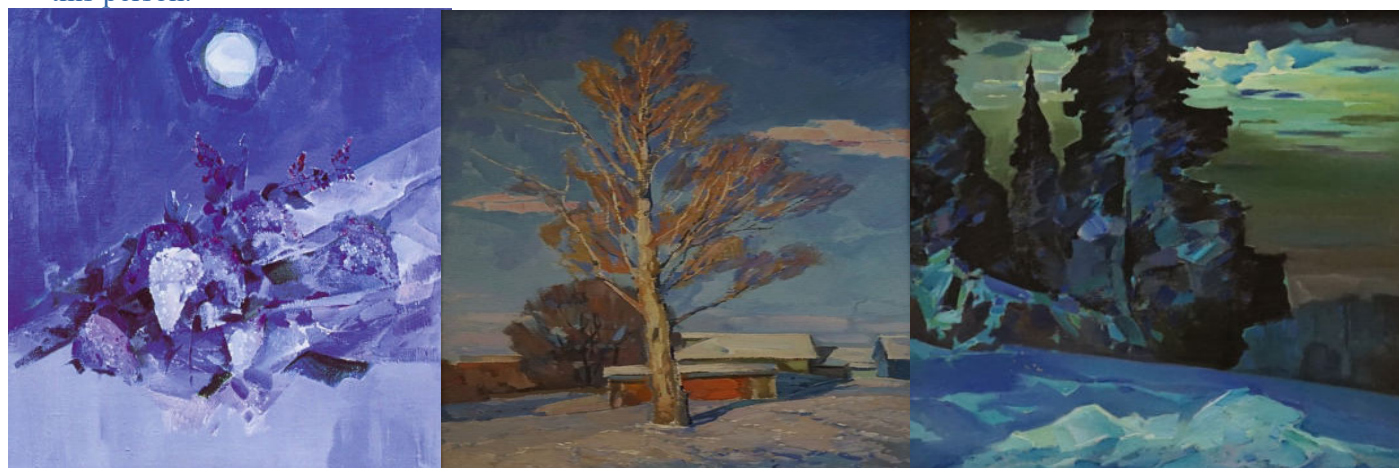

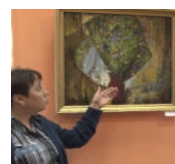
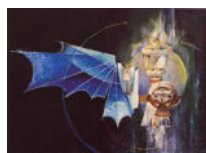

VALENTIN VASILYEVICH SARATOV(12.12.1932-16.07.2006)

Valentin V.Saratov was born on12-th December 1932, in Myshetskoe village, Khimki district, Moscow region. He wanted to become an artist fom his childhood. He lived in a very wonderful place by the lake “Krugloe” and often looked at beautiful landscapes. He graduated from the Surikov Secondary Art School at the USSR Academy in Moscow, opposite the Tretyakov Gallery. V.V. Saratov worked as the chief artist of Sheremetyevo Airport, as a landscape-artist and also worked in the advertising and design direction. In 1980 he became a member of the Union of Russian Artists. Paintings by V.V. Saratov are known not only in our country, but also abroad, they were exhibited and purchased by private gallery in America, Japan, Germany, Finland, Italy. Some of them were awarded and listed in the international catalogs. He donated more than 50 of his paintings to the Solnechnogorsk town, Khimki district, they decorated several halls of the Museum and Exhibition Center “Travel Palace”.

The leaders of the collective, The Kobesovs -Georgiy and Elizaveta, are multiple winners of competitions, holders of scholarships from the mayor and the governor of the Moscow region, they have been awarded honorary and gratitude letters.

The most significant awards for the collective are: Twice holders of the title "Grand Prix" of the X Jubilee Festival of Orthodox Culture and Traditions of Small Towns and Rural Settlements of Russia "Sophia"; Regional folk dance competition "Knyazevskie Vstrechi" - Laureate of the 3rd degree; All-Russian Festival of National Cultures - Laureates of the 1st degree; International competition "Open Pages. Yaroslavl" - Laureates of the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd degrees; Interzonal small forms competition "Adagio" - Laureate of the 2nd degree; All-Russian competition "LEVEL UP" - Laureates of the 1st and 2nd degrees; International competition "Triumph of Dance" - Laureates of the 1st degree; All-Russian competition "City of Masters-Dmitrov" - Laureates of the 1st and 2nd degrees etc.

The collective also has special prizes from the jury - "For high performance mastery", "Stage charm and artistry", "Musicality of performance", "For staging and performance culture".

And this is just a small part of the collective's awards. The educators strive to form a harmonious personality, teaching students various skills and abilities.

The idea of this article I took from my student of the 10th form Andrey K. Once he told me about people who made a great contribution to the history and development of Khimki. You know, I am not from Khimki, so his information was seemed to me worth to share.

Talking about the town we usually mention its history and the people who personify it and whom we must treat with respect. Read about three famous people associated with Khimki and their historical and cultural contribution to the history of Khimki.



Serednikovo Estate, that belongs to the district of Khimki is one of the popular Lermontov's places. This manor belonged to his grandmother. Here the poet firstly fell in love and wrote his youthful poems. Here he loved to dream alone in the thicket of the forest and recall his mother, who died when he was not even three years old. And this year when we celebrate the 210th anniversary of Mikhail Yuryevich Lermontov, festivals and tours are offered for Kimki's citizens and guests in this wonderful place.



Anfisa Anatolyevna Reztsova is the only Olympic champion in biathlon and cross-country skiing in history. After a lot of triumphs in skiing and giving birth two of her daughters she decided to try herself in biathlon with her husband as a couch. This further emphasizes the strength of her character and fortitude. Being champion many times she gave birth two more daughters! The Reztsov's family lives in Kimki. Her older daughters Daria and Kristina are also biathletes. Unfortunately, last year Anfisa Anatolyevna Reztsova is decease.



In my opinion, Vladimir Lenin's wife Nadezhda Konstantinovna Krupskaya played a very significant role in the development of Khimki in the field of education and culture. Do you know that the Moscow State Institute of Culture (at that time the Moscow Library Institute) was founded by her initiative? Also, she pay attention to the development of logistics in Khimki. It was she who initiated the opening of the Levoberezhnaya railway platform that now is the part of MCD3 and is used by hundreds of passengers a day, as this is more convenient.

Matveev Vasily Ivanovich is a veteran of the Great Patriotic War, a teacher, an Honored Teacher of the USSR. The School 8 in Khimki bears his name, and a memorial plaque in his honor was unveiled on the building. Vasily Ivanovich was the first director of this school and led it for sixteen years from the date of its opening in 1956.



Ulanov Dmitry Petrovich was the first principal of School 7 since 1966. Dmitry Petrovich participated in the Great Patriotic War, was awarded many military medals, later became an Honored teacher of schools of the USSR, an Honorary citizen of Khimki.



Each of us must feel responsible to the memory of these people. These are people of a happy fate. They left a bright mark on our city, lived an interesting, but not an easy life. Having chosen the profession of a teacher, giving their hearts to children, they worked all their lives for the benefit of their Motherland.

**OUTSTANDING PEOPLE OF KHMKI –
YURI MALYSHEV**

The history of the city's development is connected with the people who inhabit it. There are many outstanding people living in our city. Heroes of the Great Patriotic War, heroes of labor, artists, musicians, actors and, of course, athletes. For example, a real rowing legend lives in Khimki- Yuri Aleksandrovich Malyshev.

Legendary rower, Honored Master of Sports of the USSR in academic rowing, 1972 Olympic champion in single sculls. Yuri Malyshev was born on February 1, 1947 in the Moscow region city of Khimki. He is an Honored Master of Sports of the USSR, Honored Trainer of Russia, Honored Worker of Physical Culture of Russia.

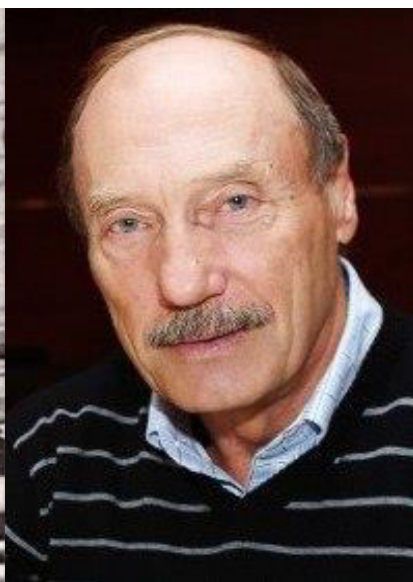
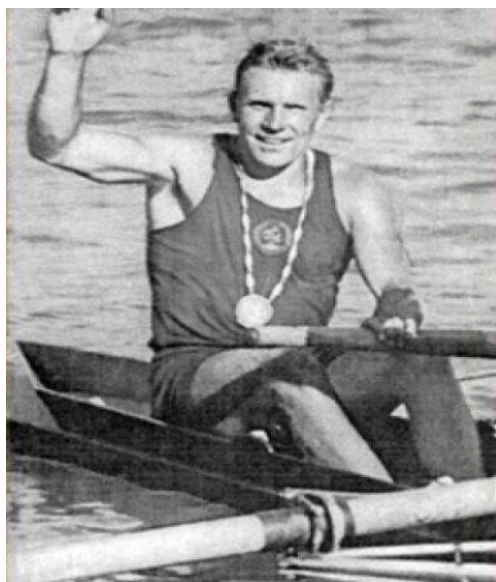
He spent his childhood in the village of Lobanovo on Stanislavsky Street and attended school No. 9 in Khimki. In 1964, he joined the rowing section, which was located at the Mayak sports base in Khimki on the bank of the Moscow Canal. After school, he worked at the Fakel plant and continued training. In 1966, he was drafted into the army.

In 1970, he was included in the USSR national team and competed in the World Championships in Canada (1970) and the European Championships (1971), four-time USSR champion in 1971, 1972 in single sculls.

In 1972, he became the champion of the XX Olympic Games (Munich) in single sculls. He became the third and last Soviet Olympic champion in the single sculls race, returning one of the most honorable titles to our country. For his great work and victory, he was awarded the title of Honored Master of Sports of the USSR and the Order of the Badge of Honor. Thanks to the victory of our fellow countryman at the Olympics, rowing in Khimki became one of the most popular sports.

After finishing his career in big-time sports, Yuri Alexandrovich switched to coaching. He trained 12 masters of sports in rowing. Since 1983, he worked as a coach, and then as a senior coach of the sculls in the USSR and Russian national team. Having a high level of knowledge in his chosen profession and many years of experience as a rowing coach allowed him to achieve significant results in his work. In 2004, he trained a team of champions of the **XXVIII Summer Olympic Games** in the men's quadruple sculls class (Athens). Since 1980, this is the only victory of rowers at the Olympic Games in rowing.

Yuri Aleksandrovich Malyshev is now 76 years old. He worked as a coach for many years. He recently retired, but continues to hold meetings with young athletes.

HERO OF THE SOVIET UNION VLADIMIR MIKHAILOVICH TYUKOV

Hero of the Soviet Union - Vladimir Mikhailovich Tyukov

Vladimir Mikhailovich Tyukov was born in the city of Maykop on June 17, 1921 in a military family. In 1934 moved to the village of Skhodnya. Volodya studied at Skhodnya's school № 1 (now Lyceum № 21 in Khimki). He graduated from 7th grade and entered the Moscow Welding College. In the second year of study, in 1939 he entered the Aero club, where he began to study flying. Volodya successfully passed the exams and was sent to the Kiev Higher Flight School.



the city of Khimki even painted a portrait of Tyukov.

At the request of our school, one of the streets of the Skhodnya is named after him – **Tyukov Street**. And there is a memorial plaque on the wall of the school building.



Nowadays, the school has a great museum where everyone can hear and see everything about the hero of the school. The "Hero's Desk" participated in the regional exhibition of schools' museums.

On the day of the outbreak of war on June 22, 1941, when the Nazis attacked our homeland, this school was located between Kiev and Zhytomyr. The airfield of the school was bombed on the first day of the war. But the Nazis did not manage to cause much damage to the planes.

The school was closed, Volodya continued to study in Engelsk and graduated there. On August 6, 1942 he was sent to the front. He flew an **IL-2 bomber**.

Attack pilot V. M. Tyukov took part in the battles for the defense of the Caucasus, the liberation of Kuban,

Taman and the Crimea, showed exceptional courage and bravery, made 115 successful sorties.

He fought air battles with enemy fighters and won! He was awarded two orders:

**"Red Star Order",
"the Order of the Patriotic War of the 1st degree" and
the Medal for Bravery.**

On April 13, 1944 he received the title **"Hero of the Soviet Union"** for heroic achievements.

A few days later, on April 24, 1944 Vladimir Tyukov died a brave death defending his Homeland in the sky over Sevastopol.

Vladimir's family took part in the city's events dedicated to the Great Patriotic War. His mother and sister told everyone about the hero's achievements. The artist of

Tatyana Mikhailovna Istomina

The teacher of school No. 12 in Khimki.

Tatyana M. Istomina, was born in 1927, she got higher education, was the member of the Communist Party of the USSR, her teaching experience is 43 years.

T.M. Istomina came to Khimki in 1946 as a young teacher of Chemistry and Biology to school No. 6 in Khimki.

She devoted 41 years of her labour to education in Khimki. 36 years she worked as the head of the educational part of school No. 6 in Khimki, the principal of Starbeyevskaya school, the principal of school No. 5 in Khimki.

School No. 5 in Khimki, which was headed by Tatyana Mikhailovna Istomina for 20 years, was written into the regional Book of Honor of Khimki. It was achieved thanks to the great energy and initiative work of T.M. Istomina and her ability to focus the teaching staff on the solution of educational tasks.

T.M. Istomina was the leader of a huge historical and scientific work on the history of public education in Khimki. Together with teachers and students followed the fates of graduates (residents of Khimki) of the oldest Khimki school № 5. As a result of that work there was the decision of the Khimki's City Executive Committee to name one of the streets of Khimki in honour of Kudryavtsev - a graduate of school № 5, heroically died during the Great Patriotic War.

T.M. Istomina was the first teacher of the district to start working on the protection of small rivers in the surroundings of Khimki, for that she was awarded the badge "For the Defense of Nature in Russia" by the Presidium of the Central Council of the All-Russian Society for Nature Conservation.

T.M. Istomina was elected a deputy of the Khimki's City Council of People's Deputies for three terms, 5 years of which she headed the deputy group of public education.

For her work T.M.Istomina was awarded the Diploma of Khimki's Executive Committee, the CPSU State Committee, the Main Department of Public Education of Mosoblispolkom, "The Excellent Educator of the USSR", T.M.Istomina was awarded the medal 'The Veteran of Labour', the medal 'For Valorous Labor in commemoration of the 100th anniversary of the birth of Lenin, badges 'Winner of Socialist Competition" - 1974, 1975.

At present, after retirement, she continues her work as a teacher of geography at school № 12 in Khimki.

She is the example to follow to young teachers and the member of the school's trade union committee.

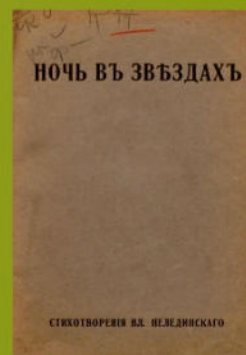

Poet Vladimir Gippius

Vladimir Gippius was a Russian critic, poet, prose writer, and teacher. Vladimir Gippius was born on July 15, 1876, in Khimki. Vladimir's family was descended from an old family of natives of Germany, to which belonged Zinaida Gippius. He studied at the gymnasium with A. Dobrolyubov, together with him he began a literary career.

As a student of the faculty of History and Philology of Saint Petersburg University, Vladimir Gippius published a collection of poems "Songs" (1897). In 1912, he published the book "Return" (under the pseudonym Vladimir Bestuzhev), in 1915 - the collection "Night in the stars" (under the pseudonym Vladimir Neledinsky). In 1916, "Almanac of the Muses" published his poem "Love" and published the collection "Yearning of the spirit". Vladimir Gippius taught literature at the Stoyunina Gymnasium, the First Saint Petersburg Gymnasium, and the Tenishev school.

His work was highly regarded by his contemporaries, and his influence continues to be felt in Russian literature today. He died of starvation in 1941 during the siege of Leningrad.
