**2. Discuss the Grammar Material: “Subordinating Conjunctions of Condition” and “Would – Past Tense”. Read this information, translate into Russian and make up your own sentences for each point.**

*A) Subordinating Conjunctions of Condition:*

<b>Point 1: Subordinating conjunctions of condition</b> show how one action depends on another action.	1. I will call you <b>if</b> I am late. 2. <b>If</b> you feel sick, you can stay home. 3. <b>As long as</b> you exercise, you will stay in shape. 4. I cannot buy a house year <b>unless</b> I win the lottery!
<b>Point 2:</b> <b>If</b> shows a condition. One action depends on another action.	1. <b>If</b> it rains, we will not play tennis. 2. We will not play tennis <b>if</b> it rains. 3. <b>If</b> you help me, I can pay you. 4. I can pay you <b>if</b> you help me.
<b>Point 3: Unless</b> shows a condition. One action depends on another action. <b>Unless</b> is similar to <b>if .. not</b> .	1. <b>Unless</b> you study, you cannot pass the test. 2. <b>If</b> you do not study, you cannot pass the test. 3. Do not call me <b>unless</b> you are serious. 4. Do not call me <b>if</b> you are <b>not</b> serious.

<b>Point 4:</b> <b>As long as</b> means <b>if</b> but it often shows a negative consequence to an action.	<p>1. <b>As long as</b> we leave now, we can arrive in time.</p> <p>2. We can arrive in time <b>as long as</b> we leave now.</p> <p>3. We will play tennis <b>as long as</b> it does not rain.</p> <p>4. <b>As long as</b> it does not rain, we will play tennis.</p>

*B) Would – Past Tense:*

<b>Point 1:</b> Use the modal <b>would</b> to talk about activities you often did in the past, but no longer do.	<p>(Q) As a kid on the farm, what <b>did</b> you do?</p> <p>(A) I did a lot. I <b>would</b> ride horses.</p> <p>(N) I <b>wouldn't</b> stay inside.</p> <p>(Q) Where <b>would</b> you play?</p> <p>(A) I <b>would</b> play in the garden.</p> <p>(N) I <b>wouldn't</b> see anyone.</p>
<b>Point 2:</b> Use <b>would</b> to for things you did often. Use the simple past for actions you just did once.	<p>(Q) Who <b>did</b> you talk to as a kid?</p> <p>(A) I talked with my friends.</p> <p>(A) We <b>would</b> talk for hours.</p> <p>(N) I <b>wouldn't</b> say much.</p>
<b>Point 3:</b> We use 'd as a contraction for would in spoken English.	<p>(Q) When <b>would</b> you get up?</p> <p>(A) I'd wake up very early.</p> <p>(N) I'd never sleep in.</p> <p><b>Note:</b> Do not use the contraction in short answers.</p> <p>(Q) <b>Would</b> you go to town?</p> <p>(A) Yes, I <b>would</b> sometimes.</p> <p>(N) No, <b>wouldn't</b> usually.</p>
<b>Point 4:</b> We use <b>used to</b> to introduce an action we no longer do, and then switch to would for related actions.	<p>1) I <b>used to</b> play soccer a lot. I <b>would</b> play from morning till night.</p> <p>2) I <b>used to</b> get in trouble a lot. I <b>would</b> make my teacher so mad.</p> <p>3) I <b>used to</b> have a motorcycle. I <b>would</b> ride it for hours.</p>
